- Please prepare 16 bars from a Broadway musical (traditional/classic selections only) to best represent your voice and range. An accompanist will be provided and no tapes/CDs will be permitted.
- Please prepare a 1-minute monologue.
- Bring comfortable clothing/footwear and be prepared to learn a short dance combination.
- Auditions are open to adults only (21+ years of age).
- YOU MUST HAVE A PERFORMANCE RESUME to audition.

Footlighters will close their 2011-2012 season with the regional community theatre premiere of Showtune! "Put on your Sunday Clothes" and enjoy this toe-tapping revue celebrating the work of Jerry Herman, composer and lyricist for some of Broadway's greatest shows and recipient of the 2009 Tony Award for Lifetime Achievement in the Theater. Incorporating hit song after hit song, Showtune is sure to please audiences young and old alike with witty lyrics set to iconic tunes from shows including Hello, Dolly!, Mame, Mack & Mabel and La Cage aux Folles.

Cast requirements:

The cast includes 6 principal roles and potentially, a small ensemble.

- MAN #1: Leading man type, wise, with humor; 30s-40s; Legit voice needed; Bass/Baritone: Low A to F
- MAN #2: Comic, in prime of life; 30s-40s; Legit voice needed; Baritone/Tenor: Low G to high G or A
- MAN #3: Young leading man, dance or strong movement a plus; 20s-30s; Legit voice needed; Strong Tenor: Low A flat to high A
- WOMAN #1: Leading woman type, comedian; 30s-40s; Alto: Low F sharp to high C sharp; Legit voice and strong belt needed; Some soprano singing will be required
- WOMAN #2: Sassy personality with humor, in prime of life; 30s-40s; Alto/Soprano: Low F; Legit voice and strong belt needed; High belt to C sharp; Some soprano singing will be required
- WOMAN #3: Ingénue with a sprightly comic flair, dancing a plus; 20s-30s; Soprano: Low G to high A, with belt; Legit voice needed
- ENSEMBLE: We may be adding a small ensemble; Age: 20s-40s
